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• Curriculum, Academics, and Master Scheduling

- The master schedule for 2019-2020 has been drafted. The new schedule requires that students be double-booked for English, Math, and Biology. Administration will begin scheduling students in March 2019 for the upcoming academic year.
- o Quarter 2 ended on February 18, 2019. Report cards were distributed to students.
- o Midterm examinations were administered and were successful. Teachers used a standards-based report card to grade the midterm exam, which was provided to parents on February 6, 2019 at the parent conference day.
- The school has started the process to obtain accreditation for Middle States. We hope to have the accreditation by Summer 2022

Special Events

- Eligible high school students will be attending the Movie Theatre on Tuesday, March 5, 2019. Eligible middle school students will be attending Bounce Town on Thursday, March 7, 2019. Both trips are incentives for students that are excelling academically and behaviorally in accordance with IAA's Cougar Behavioral System.
- o A dance was hosted for middle school students on Valentine's Day. The event was successful, and more than 100 students were in attendance.
- o Due to snow, 5 days of school has been missed this month. However, 7 snow days are built into the calendar, so students and staff will not need to makeup those days.
