Chief School Administrator Report	 Marketing and Recruiting School administrators met with the Director of Marketing with the Lehigh Valley Mall in April 2018 to discuss a comprehensive marketing campaign. The meeting was successful. The school is gearing up for an Open House event on May 3-May 4, 2018 and on June 4-June 5, 2018. We hope to welcome 50 new students at each event! The school has launched several advertising campaigns to recruit students and spread brand awareness. Our marketing partner has been instrumental in facilitating success for the school. The logo and branding project has started. The school picked initial logo materials but additional adjustments are still needed. The Principal and Director of Admissions has developed a 90 day marketing action plan to guide recruitment efforts. To meet recruitment goals, the school must enrollment at least 180 students by August 2018. Information Technology 			

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- o The school continues to work with Singularis IT to meet technology needs.
- o The school has secured fiber optic internet to facilitate faster internet speeds.
- o Increased internet speeds have had a tremendous impact on the utilization of technology within the school. We look forward to using technology much more!

Curriculum and Master Scheduling

- o Course selection for 2018-2019 has been completed. The student services department will now work to input student schedule requests in a timely fashion.
- o PSSA exams are currently in progress. Students must complete an English, Math, and Science PSSA exam. The administration has been successful.
- High school students will take the Keystone Exam in May in English, Biology, and Algebra I.
- The school will host a summer school program to support at-risk students that have failed the Keystone Exam in Algebra, Biology, or English. Summer school will also be open to students that have not passed either of the Keystone tested courses.
- o A professional science and math consultant has been contracted to improve programming in these areas.

Human Resources

- Dr. Tanya Shankweiler began her new role as the school psychologist in March 2018. She has been instrumental in the planning process for 2018-2019.
 Dr. Shankweiler joins us from the Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 in Easton.
- Carlos Pujols began his new role as the Assistant Dean of Students in April 2018 in place of Diane Wilson, who resigned for a promotion with another organization. Carlos joins us from the Lehigh County Juvenile Probation Office.
- The school has hired a professional consultant to conduct a human resources audit and provide relevant trainings to school administration. The audit will be completed during the first week of May 2018.

- An advisor has been assigned to the school, and communication has occurred frequently in order to prepare needed documents.
